Four levels of primary living space await inside. There's a media/fitness studio with a full bath on the first floor, and a full-floor roof terrace with stunning and captivating views of the modern San Francisco skyline crowns the home. The gracious entry on the third floor of the building allows the owner a comfortable and inviting welcome to the home.

The entry level holds the home's first guest suite and the additional rear internal stair down that leads to the private garage, wine cellar and fitness studio. Continuing up the custom oval white oak staircase is the guest level with three bedrooms, each with their own bathroom and a private study. The floor above is the main living space with a full floor open floor plan, sliding glass doors to the large main terrace and a chef's kitchen built with custom cabinetry and Calacatta Italian marble finishes.

Up the staircase is the full-floor owner's suite with a luxurious, spacious bathroom, cityscape views and a large walk-in closet with custom built-in shelving.

The home's top floor is an expansive sky terrace with a built-in gas fire pit and both an outdoor living room and dining room with one of the most unique and dynamic views of the skyline. 17 Guy Place is truly a once in a generation custom built residence in the heart of the city.

GUEST RESIDENCE

A more intimate lower floor two-bedroom, two-and-a-half bathroom, two-level quest suite: The guest residence's spacious open floor plan and floor-toceiling windows bring an abundance of natural light to the thoughtful main living space. The custom kitchen is wrapped in Calacatta Italian marble and is a perfect pairing with the homes rift cut white oak floors.
