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Bauhaus Design and Endless Views in Eureka Valley

Perched on a quiet ridge in Eureka Valley, this architecturally stunning Bauhaus Modern home has been renovated and expanded and captures spectacular San Francisco views from all four levels.

The home boasts four bedrooms, four full bathrooms, an office area, and an additional family room with an adjacent formal dining area. As you walk through the gated entryway at the street, you are greeted with a landscaped garden courtyard. Hiding below the grass area was once a reflection pool, which could easily be reverted back.

Through the front door is the main entertaining level of the home, which boasts incredible views. The professional kitchen features stainless steel appliances and includes a breakfast nook adjacent to double doors that open onto the front garden.

The large center island allows for endless entertaining and is an ideal gathering space. The lower level of the home has a functional family room plus an area for formal dining if so desired by the new homeowners. Through the double doors is a large covered patio with downtown views. The patio provides access to the garden area, complete with a seating area and an additional level with artificial grass and a kids play slide.

The incredibly quiet and private garden is a remarkable refuge from the bustling city below.

Three spacious bedrooms are located in the middle level of the home, all boasting an abundance

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of natural light through the architectural window systems. Two of these bedrooms have en suite bathrooms, complete with new tile and grout creating a fresh and modern look.

The primary suite occupies the top level of the home, boasting a large walk-out terrace with fantastic views. The primary bathroom features a walk-in stall shower along with a separate soaking tub sitting under a window, to create an immersive spa-like experience.

Adjacent to the primary suite is a multipurpose area that could be used as an office or a storage area, with an additional deck attached to it with Twin Peak views. Additional home features include hardwood floors, integrated sound, and one-car garage. Nestled just one block to Noe Valley, 429 Douglass St. is located on a quiet dead-end street with easy access to shops, parks, cafes, and restaurants.
